

Tools for Redeploying Advanced Practice Providers During COVID-19



Redefining the care delivery team is critical to meeting important patient needs in a rapidly changing health care environment. Short-Term

- Conduct a full **inventory** of physician and APP **skills sets**
- Develop a **cross-training plan** focused on critical service areas such the intensive care unit, hospital medicine, emergency room and rapid response teams.
- Implement a process for **rapid deployment** in new care settings
- Establish **electronic health records and billing processes** to account for and capture APP services provided in critical specialties
- Include **APP leaders** in key communications and **emergency response planning**
- Create a plan to support **physician and APP resiliency**

Long-Term

- **Optimize care teams** to maximize access, address ambulatory and surgical backlogs, and increase productivity and revenue
- **Align APP leadership structure** to organizational goals, including implementing lessons learned and the development of future response plans
- **Create an organizational onboarding process** that includes **specific APP components** and is responsive to urgent staffing needs
- **Integrate APPs** into **innovative care delivery** models such as telemedicine
- Develop aligned physician and APP **pay practices** to support flexibility and optimization
